SHABBAT SHEOALIM





On Shabbat Sheqalim, in addition to the regular Torah portion, we are obligated to read an additional section from the Torah that describes the collection of the

annual half-sheqel donation from every Jew for the upkeep of the Holy Temple. It is not enough to be reminded to perform the mitzvah of donating the half-sheqel; it is imperative that community members understand and reflect upon the meaning of their actions. The mitzvah of giving a half-sheqel teaches us that we cannot expect other members of the community to participate in religious functions and keep Jewish tradition alive while we sit back and watch. The Torah requires every Jew to contribute to the Temple so that we come to appreciate the importance of active involvement in Judaism. Hashem summons all of us to be fully engaged with our communities and to contribute positively and productively to the maintenance of our traditions and institutions. No one else can do it for us - our future and the future of the Jewish people will be the one that we create through our combined efforts, one half-shegel at a time, together.


