## Second Chances

The Hebrew month of lyyar contains a fascinating minor holiday known as Pesach Sheni, or the Second Passover. The Torah tells us that a group of people who were ritually impure were forbidden from offering the Paschal sacrifice in the wilderness the very first year that the Jews celebrated Passover as a holiday. Upset about their exclusion from the event, they approached Moshe Rabbenu and requested that he offer them some kind of a compromise so they would not lose out. Hashem instructs Moshe to tell the nation that, from now on, anyone who is ritually unfit to bring the Passover sacrifice at its proper time on the 14th of Nissan will be deferred one month and will offer it on the 14th of Iyyar instead.

It is remarkable that this commandment was revealed only after some disenfranchised individuals were unhappy with the status quo and petitioned for change. The lesson here is that we should not sit back, remain passive, and allow opportunities to slip through our fingers. Success comes when we stand up, speak out and refuse to take "no" for an answer; we must seek solutions if we are to find them. Our acknowledgment of the "Second Passover" should include reflection on the importance of passionately advocating for ourselves and our families in all areas of life - religious, educational, social and practical.

## Cheesecake Recipe By @TheKosherChef

### **INGREDIENTS:**

#### Crust

- 200 gram (7oz) of Graham cracker crumbs (or any of your favorite )
- 1 stick of unsalted and melted butter

#### Filling

- 2 1/2 packages of cream cheese (each 8oz), room temperature
- 1 box of Mascarpone cheese.
- 1 cup of sugar
- 1 teaspoons vanilla
- 5 large eggs
- lemon zest

### **RECIPE:**

#### Prepare the crust

1. Preheat oven to 325°F, with rack in lower third of oven. Pulse the graham crackers in a food processor or blender until finely ground. Put in a large bowl, and stir in themelted butter.

2. Put all of the graham cracker crumbs in the bottom of the springform pan. Gently press down on the crumbs using your fingers, until the crumbs are a nice even layer at the bottom of the pan.

#### Make the filling

3. Cut the cream cheese into chunks, add Mascarpone cheese and place in the bowl of an electric mixer, with the paddle attachment. Mix on medium speed for 4 minutes until smooth, soft and creamy. Add the sugar, beat for 4 minutes more. Add the vanilla, beating after each addition. Add the eggs, one at a time, beating for one minute after each addition. Add the lemon zest beat until incorporated.

4. Pour filling on the crust and place inside the overn for about 1 1/2 hours.

5. Turn off the heat of the oven. Crack open the oven door 1-inch, and let the cake cool in the oven, as the oven cools, for another hour. This gentle cooling will help prevent the cheesecake surface from cracking.

6. Cover the top of the cheesecake with foil, so that it doesn't actually touch the cheesecake. Chill in the refrigerator for a minimum of 4 hours, or overnight.
