HIGHER EDUCATION COMMITTEE MASHADI STUDENT LOAN PROGRAM SPRING 2016 SEMESTER

The Mashadi Cultural and Educational Committee (Higher Education Committee) would like to inform our Community's students about the Interest-Free Mashadi Student Loan Program. The student loan program is based only on financial need. Student loans are for both undergraduate and post-graduate studies. All Community applicants for the 2016 Spring Semester must complete and email a loan application form, along with a scanned copy of their registered tuition bill no later than Friday, January 8, 2016. Applications can be downloaded from the right side of the UMJCA homepage at www.mashadi.org. All applications & tuition bills should be emailed to Marty Bassaly at MBassaly@aol.com. All loan applications are strictly confidential and will be reviewed by the Mashadi Higher Ed Student Loan Review Committee to determine what amount (if any) can be disbursed. Repayment of Student Loans are to be made over a 3 year period (1/3 each year) following graduation so that future Mashadi students can also receive the same assistance. NOTE: In 2010, an Education Fund was established for Post Graduates, called the Laleh Hannah Nassimi Memorial Foundation. The Foundation provides financial assistance to qualifying Mashadi students based on both need and merit. Funds are available for Post-Graduate studies (Masters, PhD, Law School, Med School, etc) in the United States only. The Higher Education Committee strongly encourages all qualifying Mashadi students to apply using the same application noted above.





MYC Directory Guidelines and Privacy

In May of of 2014, after much deliberation by the Marriage Committee and with cooperation by members of the MYC, the MYC Directory was launched under the domain name MYCDirectory.com. The initial sole purpose of this

directory was to create a "yearbook style" listing of all the singles in the community ranging from 18-45 years of age. The directory would only be accessible by its own members, and the official dating mentors elected by the marriage committee for the community. Each of the singles would have an account profile and unique password to enter, and participation in the directory would be mandatory to remove any stigma amongst the youth and create a 'level playing field'. Upon entry, each member would see three pages; a profile page to update their picture and information, a page listing all of the single girls in the community in alphabetical order, and a page listing all of the single boys in the community in alphabetical order. The only information shown on these two lists would be a profile image, the member's full name and the names of their parents. Given the fact that statistically there are approximately 1,000 documented singles in our community of 6,000, the objective was to provide exposure to the singles who otherwise may not attend synagogue or social functions and bring focus to one's availability within the community. The directory was also used as a tool for the dating mentors to utilize in their efforts. In recent months, the Marriage Committee had discussed taking the directory to the next level and providing interactivity for the singles, while of course safeguarding their privacy first and foremost. The intention for this next phase was to alleviate some of the social issues that have been reported and analyzed by the official dating mentors, and to reintroduce a similar concept that was developed many years ago to create a system that would find matches instigated by the members themselves. This second phase of the MYC Directory is now ready to launch.

With this second phase (which is completely optional to all members), the members will have the ability to add other members they may be interested in to one of five slots, called a "Hot List". Once a member has been added to a hot list, they must remain there for a minimum of two weeks. If two members have each other on their hot list at the same time, the system will detect a match and notify both parties. If a member adds someone to their hot list, and after a lengthened period of time they see a match is not happening, this can provide some insight to the member that it might be best to move on and replace them on the list without facing a personal rejection. Some other features and functions are as follows:

- •When you add a member to your Hot List, an anonymous email is sent to that person letting them know someone has chosen them. They would then have to log into the directory and make their selections and hope for a match to be detected.
- •When creating your list, you have the option to have one of the dating mentors notified of your matches to provide you assistance. You can specify the dating mentor you feel most comfortable with. In the event of a match, if one member requested a dating mentor to be notified and the other did not, the dating mentor specified will only be notified of the member that requested them.
- •The directory will remember your past selections and will still detect a match if both parties chose each other but after one side was already removed. These "Archive Matches" are handled differently. Instead of sending an automatic notification to both parties, the match is sent to a dating coach to contact and see if both sides are still available and willing.
- •In each member's profile, there are additional fields to enter an email address and mobile number. On your hot list, you have the option to request one-of or both of those fields to be sent to the member you were matched with, aside from just your name.
- •Only after a member has been added to your hot list, you will be able to see if the member chosen has created their list or not. This is indicated by a simple red light or green light, and does not specify who or how many slots they have chosen. The purpose for this feature is to stop you from waiting forever, should you see the member you were interested in has already created their list.
- •Additional fields have been added to extend on the basic profile for each member. These optional questions are used to assist the dating mentors in their efforts.

Possible Future Options

- •When adding someone to your hot list, you will have the option to not have it be anonymous, and let them know you were the one that chose them.
- •You will be shown 15 random people, with at least one having chosen you. Further narrowing down and providing some insight into who added you to their hot list.

All member information including your hot list selections are strictly private and only known to you. None of the committee members or even the official dating mentors have access to view anyone's hotlist. The hotlist is encrypted and secure, and your interaction with the hotlist is under 256-bit SSL (secure socket layer) security. If you are a potential member and have not received your password, and are not able to retrieve one using the forgot password link on the login page, it is possible we either do not have your email or you may not be in the directory. In this case, please send an email to mycdirectory@gmail.com with your name and the name of your parents and we will create an account for you. We hope that with the cooperation of Hashem above all, and the youth, we will see an increase in smachot in our community.
