PASSOVER RICE INFORMATION 2016

As per phone conversations with rice importers, Rabbi Eliyahu Ben Haiim has confirmed that the following brands of rice are 100% pure, no additives, or preservatives, or vitamins. Therefore, they are suitable for use for Passover. The brands are: Royal, Pari, Dee, Zebra, Empire, Colbeh Brand, Lal Qilla, Dunar, Dunar Brown, Kohinoor. Even though these rices are pure, lewish law requires that the rice be cleaned three times and washed thoroughly before use for Passover. Please avoid using any enriched rice.



How Jonathan Met Sharone by Leah Hakimian
